The representation received from Shri Biswajit Bhowmick, A.C., placed opposite may please be seen.

In the afore said representation it is stated that Shri Dinabandhu Sai, A.C., being Junior is drawing more Pay.

On scrutiny of the Service Book of Shri Biswajit Bhowmick, A.C., it is found that Shri Bhowmick is getting less pay in comparison to Shri Dinabandhu Sai, as per the seniority position of Shri Dinabandhu Sai is 4099 as on 01.08.2013 published under O.M. C.No. II(34)1-ET/A-3/Con/Kol-I/2013/22341-366B dated 09.09.2013 (F/A) and the seniority position of Shri Biswajit Bhowmick, is 4084 respectively.

The anomaly of pay arrived due to awarding of MACP after implication of the CPC. In this connection it is to mention here that in terms of OM No. 35034/3/2015 - Estt(D) dated 22.10.19 vide para 20 (F/B) it has been stated that stepping-up shall be done w.e.f. the date of MACP of the Junior Government Servant subject to the full fillment of the following condition namely :-

- both the junior and senior Government servants belong to the same cadre and they are in the same pay Level on grant of MACP;
- the existing pay structure and the revised pay structure of the lower and higher posts in which they are entitled to draw pay are identical;
- the senior Government servants at the time of grant of MACP are drawing equal or more pay than the junior;
- the anomaly is directly as a result of the application of the provisions of Fundamental Rule 22 or any other rule or order regular pay fixation on such grant of MACP in the revised pay structure;

On scrutiny of the Service Book of Shri Dinabandhu Sai, it is observed that Pay Fixation of Shri Dinabandhu Sai, i.e. from 01.07.2016 as per F.F. 22 I(a)(1) and pay fixed at Rs. 90,000/- whereas there pay of Shri Biswajit Bhowmick was Rs. 87,000/- as on 01.07.2016.

So, the stepping up of pay may be granted to Shri Dinabandhu Sai, A.C., in comparison with their Junior at per w.e.f. 01.07.2016 and basic pay should be Rs. 90,000/- and D.N.I. of Shri Biswajit Bhowmick, will be on 01.01.2017 as per O.M. No. 4-21/2017-IC/E.IIIA dated 28.11.2019 (F/C).

In the afore said representation it is stated that Shri Tapan Halder, A.C., Junior to the above officer is drawing more Pay.

On scrutiny of the Service Book of Shri Subir Das, A.C., it is found that he is getting less pay in comparison to Shri Tapan Halder, A.C.

A certificate of Pay particulars of Sri Tapan Halder throughout the service life has been furnished by the Asstt. Chief Accounts Officer of Haldia Commissionerate which is placed opposite (F/A). The seniority position of Shri Tapan Halder is 2039 as per All Inid Seniority List of Superintendent Central Excise for the period from 01.01.1998 to 31.12.2006 date of Uploading 01.12.2011 (F/B) and the seniority position of Shri Subir Das, A.C., is 1131 as per All Inida Seniority List of Superintendent Central Excise for the period from 01.01.1998 to 31.12.2006 date of Uploading 01.12.2011 (F/B).

The comparative chart (A) of both the above officer's pay since their appointment is placed opposite.

The anomaly of pay has occurred due to awarding of MACP to Shri Tapan Halder after implementation of the 7th CPC. In this connection it is to mention here that in terms of OM No. 35034/3/2015 - Estt(D) dated 22.10.19 vide para 20 (F/D) the stepping-up shall be done w.e.f. the date of MACP of the Junior Government Servant subject to the fulfilment of the following conditions namely :-

- (a) both the junior and senior Government servants belong to the same cadre and they are in the same pay Level on grant of MACP;
- (b) the existing pay structure and the revised pay structure of the lower and higher posts in which they are entitled to draw pay are identical;
- (c) the senior Government servants at the time of grant of MACP are drawing equal or more pay than the junior;
- (d) the anomaly is directly as a result of the application of the provisions of Fundamental Rule 22 or any other rule or order regular pay fixation on such grant of MACP in the revised pay structure;

It is observed from the pay statement of Shri Tapan Halder that he opted for deferred Pay Fixation i.e. from 01.07.2016 as per F.F. 22 I(a)(1) and pay fixed at Rs. 90,000/- whereas the pay of Shri Subir Das, A.C. was Rs. 87,400/- as on 01.07.2016.

So, the stepping up of pay may be granted to Shri Subir Das, A.C. at par with the pay of their Junior Shri Tapan Halder w.e.f. 01.07.2016 and basic pay may be fixed Rs. 90,000/-. The D.N.I. of Shri Subir Das, A.C. will be on 01.07.2017 as per O.M. No. 4-21/2017-IC/E.IIIA dated 28.11.2019 (F/E).

In the afore said representation it is stated that Shri Dinabandhu Sai, Assistant Commissioner, Junior to the above officer is drawing more Pay.

On scrutiny of the Service Book of Shri Biswajit Bhowmick, A.C., it is found that he is getting less pay in comparison to Shri Dinabandhu Sai, A.C.

The seniority position of Shri Dinabandhu Sai is 4099 as on 01.08.2013 published under O.M. C.No. II(34)I-ET/A-3/Con/Kol-I/2013/22341-366B dated 09.09.2013 (F/C) and the seniority position of Shri Biswajit Bhowmick, A.C. is 4084 (F/C).

The comparative chart (B) of both the above officer's pay since their appointment is placed opposite.

The anomaly of pay has occurred due to awarding of Stepping up of Pay of Shri Dinabandhu Sai, A.C. from 01.07.2016 after implementation of the 7th CPC.

It is observed that of Shri Dinabandhu Sai that he Granted Stepping-up with his junior Md. Iqbal at Rs.90,000/- (Level - 10, Cell - 17) i.e. Pay Fixation from 01.07.2016 as per F.F. 22 I(a)(i) and pay fixed at Rs. 90,000/- whereas the pay of Shri Biswajit Bhowmick, A.C., was Rs. 87,400/- as on 01.07.2016.

So, the stepping up of pay may be granted to Shri Biswajit Bhowmick, A.C. at par with the pay of their Junior Shri Dinabandhu Sai w.e.f. 01.07.2016 and basic pay may be fixed Rs. 90,000/-. The D.N.I. of Shri Dinabandhu Sai will be on 01.07.2017 as per O.M. No. 4-21/2017-IC/E.IIIA dated 28.11.2019 (F/E).

1(a) On thorough scrutiny, it is found that Kolkata South has wrongly stepped up the pay of Sri Dinabandhu Sai with reference to the pay of Md. Iqbal which is substantiated below

In Para 20 of Annexure I of DoPT OM dated 22.10.2019, it is clearly stated that where a senior government servant had been granted MACP to a higher Grade Pay before 01.01.2016, draw less pay in the revised pay structure than his junior who had been granted MACP to the higher level on or after 01.01.2016, the pay of senior Government servant in the revised pay structure shall be stepped up to an amount equal to the pay as fixed for his junior.

Though, Dinabandhu Sai had joined this department as Inspector on 14.10.1985 and got 4<sup>th</sup> MACP on 14.10.2015 after completion of 30 years of service, he is junior to Md. Iqbal in the All India Seniority List of Superintendent uploaded on CBIC website on 01.12.2011. Hence, Dinabandhu Sai is not entitled for stepping up of pay with reference to the pay of Md. Iqbal.

In the same analogy, Biswajit Bhowmik is not entitled for stepping up of pay with reference to the incorrect stepping up of pay of Dinabandhu Sai.

Kolkata South Commissionerate has also withdrawn the stepping up of pay of Sri Dinabandhu Sai vide order dated 30.07.2020 (placed opposite) on the grounds stated above. Hence, application of Sri Biswajit Bhowmik to step up the pay may be rejected. A

b) However, stepping up of pay of Sri Subir Das (Please see - N.S.P. 13) with reference to the pay of Sri Tapan Kr Halder is correct as Tapan Halder is junior to Subir Das in the seniority list. Details are given below.

Iqbal & Sri Tapan Halder. But, Sri Sarkar (Sl No. 2098 in S. List) is junior to both Md. Iqbal (1919) & Sri Tapan Halder (2039). Hence, application of Sri Sri Sarkar to step up the pay may be rejected. C
