All the concerned officers are directed to attend the offices on the above mentioned days."

The second statement of the said **Office Order No. 61** dated **18.03.2019** states the words – “concerned officers” without clarifying the category of the officers, i.e., whether those “concerned officers” as are defined under Section 3 of GST Act 2017 read with Section 2(b) of Central Excise Act 1944.


