



1. Is it a fact that the CCS (Pension) Rules, 1972 provide for advance action to be taken by the Heads of Offices and the Audit/Accounts Officers to ensure that the amount of pension and gratuity due to a retired Government employee is assessed well in time and the Pension Payment Order issued not later than one month in advance of the date of retirement.

2. Is it a fact that the competent authority shall issue the pension payment order and orders for sanctioning the other dues like leave encashment, release of PF and order for payment of lumpsum amount due for the commutation of pension . not later than one month in advance of the date of the retirement of a Government servant on attaining the age of superannuation in normal circumstances, where no communication has been made to the Govt. servant on the contrary.

3. Is it a fact that the Government would like to ensure that retiring employees should on their retirement day normally receive the final sanction of pensionary benefits. If delay in issuing a final Pension Payment Order is unavoidable, at least the benefits of provisional pension and provisional gratuity should be allowed as prescribed in the rules.

4. Is it mandatory for the competent authority to forward the service book of the Government servant duly completed, up-to-date, and any other documents relied upon for the verification of service, alongwith all documentation required for processing of the pension case and issuance of the Pension Payment order to the Accounts Officer not later than four months before the date of superannuation of a Government servant.

5. Is it a fact that there is a Govt.of India Instruction, whereby Heads of Departments/Offices were made accountable for strict compliance of Government orders for issuing authorization of Pension and Gratuity, provisional or final, on the date of retirement on

superannuation.

6. Is it a fact that Government have taken a serious view of the complaints that the provisions of the statutory rules are not being observed. Is it also a fact that Heads of Offices are advised to ensure that there is no occasion for complaints from the retiring employees and to follow the prescribed procedure in letter and spirit and the Accountability in this regard will rest with the Head of the Office concerned.
